AQUATIC LARVAE

Dragonflies and Damselflies spend most of their life as aquatic larvae, living in a wide variety of water bodies including lakes, ponds, streams, rivers and ditches. The larval stage lasts from several months to a few years, while the adult stage lasts for a few weeks to a few months during the summer.

Both larvae and adults are carnivorous and some species are voracious predators of mosquitoes.
